

Books in 1st and 2nd Samuel – Isaiah

FIRST AND SECOND SAMUEL: King Saul & King David were both men who listened to God. Put your right hand up to your ear like you are listening.

FIRST AND SECOND KINGS: There were many different kings that ruled over Israel. Make a circle using both hands and place it on your head like a crown

FIRST AND SECOND CHRONICLES: These books tell many stories about God's people. Hold your hands like a book in front of you

EZRA: Ezra led God's people back to Jerusalem. Using your right hand, make a beckoning motion as though you're asking someone to come to you

NEHEMIAH: Nehemiah rebuilt the wall around Jerusalem. Pound your fists together like hammers.

ESTHER: Esther was a beautiful queen that risked her life to save God's people. Sweep your hand in a circle around your face because that is the sign language for "beautiful".

JOB: Job had all kinds of trials. Put the back of your right hand on your forehead in a "woe is me" fashion.

PSALMS: Psalms is a collection of songs to God. Move your hands as though you are directing music.

PROVERBS: Proverbs are rules to live by. Shake your right pointer finger like a teacher saying, "Do what I say!".

ECCLESIASTES: In this book we read that there is a time for everything. Point your finger to your wrist like you are showing someone the time.

SONG OF SOLOMON: *Song of Solomon is like a love song from a man to a woman.* With both pointer fingers trace the shape of a large heart in front of you.

ISAIAH: When Isaiah hears the call from God, he says, "Here I am! Send me!" Point at your chest with your two thumbs.
