

Books in Motion Poster Jeremiah - Obadiah

JEREMIAH: *Jeremiah was called the “weeping prophet”.* Trace tears down your cheeks with your pointer fingers.

LAMENTATIONS: *People cry out to God in this book.* Clasp your hands together in front of you in a pleading motion.

EZEKIAL: *Ezekial called the people to remember God and return to Him.* Place your left hand on your hip and point up with your right pointer finger in an “aha” manner.

DANIEL: *Daniel prayed even when the king said he would be punished.* Put your hands together and bow your head like you are praying.

HOSEA: *Hosea’s life teaches us that God is always waiting for us with open arms.* Hold your hands out as though you are welcoming a big hug from someone.

JOEL: *Joel prophesied trouble would come like an army of locust when God’s people turned away from Him; but, when they return to the Lord He will restore the “years that the locusts ate.”* Put your pointer fingers beside your head like locust antennas.

AMOS: *Amos says the God spoke to His people like a roaring lion because they had turned away from Him.* Show your “claws” with both hands.

OBADIAH: *Obadiah warns that Edom will soon fall.* Raise your hands above your head and then bring them down in a falling motion.
