Part the Way.

Create two teams among the family. Place a pile of pom-poms or cotton balls along the center of a table. Place masking tape on either side of the pom-poms. Direct one team to one side of the table and the second team to the other side of the table. Provide each participant with a paper plate.

Lead the family to work with their team to fan the pom-poms away from the center of the table so that pom-poms are on the opponent's side of the tape. The first team to clear or part the pom-poms away from the center of the table wins.
