

FAQ's For Respite Night

What is respite night?

Parents can have an evening off by bringing their child(ren) with special needs (up to age 21) along with their siblings (through age 13), to this event. Kids and students will enjoy a variety of activities throughout the evening and interact with our awesome team of volunteers. Pre-registration is required to attend. Background checks are required to serve.

What will the children do?

Kids and students will get to enjoy a variety of activities that include bounce houses, games and fall activities. We will also provide a quiet room for those that need a break from all of the action.

Will dinner be served?

Yes! A pizza dinner will be served along with water. If we are unable to accommodate a child's allergy, parents are welcome to send a dinner from home. Snacks such as goldfish and rice Krispy treats will also be served. Final details about dinner will be sent the week of the event.

How does check-in work?

You will be greeted and directed by volunteers in the parking lot. Our check-in team will be waiting to help you inside the café entrance starting at 5:30. This will be the same place that you will pick up your child at 8:30.

Will there be a nurse on site?

Yes, there will be a nurse on site to assist children with emergencies or their plan of care.
