



THE MYSTERY DOCTOR

One person is selected as "The Doctor," and they leave the room while the rest of the people at the table agree on a mysterious illness (e.g., they think they are cats, they can only sing lyrics to songs, they wink every time they talk, etc.). When "The Doctor" returns, she/he asks questions of the "patients" who answer according to their illness, but without saying what it is. The game ends when "The Doctor" identifies the mysterious disease (or close enough to it) or when they have asked 20 questions, whichever comes first. Then, someone else becomes "The Doctor."



BUILD A CHURCH

Create a church together using blocks, Legos, or other building materials. Think about the different rooms a church may have and build those rooms. Once your church building is complete, add people to it! Who are you adding? What are they doing in the church? Is there a pastor? Is there a teacher? Is someone changing a baby's diaper? How do you see the body of Christ reflected at our church?

Say: While we see the body of Christ reflected at North Metro Church every Sunday, the church isn't just a building. It is all Christians everywhere! The Holy Spirit moves through all people who acknowledge Jesus as their Lord and Savior. Once the Holy Spirit is in you, you can also serve as part of the body of Christ!

They obeyed the King of Kings over the authority of anyone else. Can you think of a time when you had to choose between God's way and the world's way?
