



NAPKIN DOODLE

How to play: Each person gets a napkin and pen. One person says something to draw ("draw a giraffe eating spaghetti"), and everyone does their best doodle in 30 seconds. Pick a favorite or just laugh together. Play a few rounds naming different things to draw.



BUILD A TABERNACLE

Set out wooden blocks along with a variety of other items, such as toy tools, toy jewelry, plastic jewels, fabric, and paintbrushes. Show kids a picture of the tabernacle from a study Bible or an image search. Work together as a family to build a tabernacle.


