EAT BY NUMBERS- Each food on the plate is assigned a number. The numbers are put into a container and drawn out individually (and put back in). Everyone takes one bite of the corresponding food number drawn.



Memorize and practice this month's mighty memory verse.

Ahead of time, write each word or phrase of the key passage on a separate index card. Provide each participant a set of cards. Challenge your kids to build a house of cards with them, and practice putting the key passage in order as they build their house.

SAY: We were all created to worship God. When the Bible commands us to worship God, it is really God inviting us to do what He made us to do. God loves us and provides for us. This month, we see God's provision all over the place, including when He provided a house in which the Israelites could worship.

It was only through the power of the Lord that Moses was able to part the Red Sea for the Israelites to flee from the Egyptians.

A short devotion based on the stories of the month.

Think back to a time when someone gave you a really important job to do. Maybe you helped take care of a younger sibling? Or maybe you worked outside with your dad?
