Why does it seem as though God is moved to action when His people pray and fast?

What would be your response to the following statement: *"Prayer and Fasting are not magic tricks, but magical things happen when we pray and fast."*

Do you have any examples to share of "magical things" happening as a result of you praying and fasting?

What do the following verses from Psalms teach about God hearing the cries of His people?

Psalms 6:8, 18:8, 34:4,6,15 & 17, 55:17 and 116:1

Since God hears and responds to His people, what do you need to say to Him?

Looking back at this week's teaching and study, is there one thing you'd especially like to remember this week?
