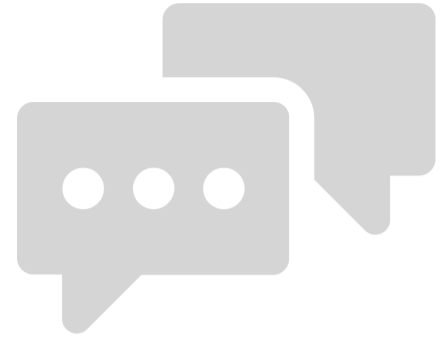

Discussion Questions

What are your reactions to Jesus' words in John 14:6?

What is Jesus saying / not saying in his statement in John 14:6?

Based on what you heard in the sermon (and what you already knew), what would you say to a friend who says:

1. All roads lead to God.
2. To claim that Jesus is the only way is exclusive.
3. There is no absolute Truth.

How have you experienced the reality that:

Truth has consequences

Truth is like a compass for life

How does the statement "Truth is not contingent upon belief or sincerity" an idea that is counter cultural to how many think in today's society?

Daniel suggested that many people reject Jesus because they like to be in control of their own lives. What helped you trust Jesus enough to give Him control of your life?

Read Acts 17:26-27 and Romans 1:18-20. How does this passage help provide an answer to the question: What about those who haven't heard about Jesus?
