5. As we celebrate the arrival of, “advent,” of King Jesus this Christmas, what are some areas in your life you need to surrender to the right rule and reign of Jesus? What areas of life are not in line with the way of Jesus and the kingdom of God?
- 6.) In the darkness we often find ourselves in or surrounded by, how can considering Advent fill you with hope and with light in the darkness?
- 7.) How can you contemplate, sing, and live out “Oh Come All Ye Faithful,” this Christmas/Advent season?
