How would you describe your relationship with forgiveness?

Read Matthew 6:12-15, Ephesians 4:31-32, Matthew 18:21-35.

What observations do you make from these verses?

What is hard and what is encouraging about these verses?

What is something that people do that frequently causes you to become frustrated with them?
Why is Jesus so concerned with you forgiving those who have hurt you?
How can our un-forgiveness affect our relationship with God? With others?
What life opportunities could un-forgiveness be preventing you from fully experiencing or enjoying?
Share about a time when someone forgave you. How can you extend that kind of forgiveness to others?
Forgiveness isn't fair and isn't restoring the relationship, but it does mean giving others what God has given us. What are some ways you can forgive and still set boundaries?
Who do you need to forgive? What's your action plan?
What actions steps do you need to take? How can we pray for you?
