Discussion Questions:

How would you answer the following question: What's the point of the church?

When working as part of a team, do you prefer to "do the work" or to lead and coordinate others?

Read Acts 6:1-7

What problem arose in the early church regarding people's needs?

The leaders took the complaint seriously enough to do something about it, how do we respond when conflict arises? How should we respond?

What solution did the Apostles offer? Why didn't they volunteer to be the solution?

The seven men chosen (later called deacons, meaning servants) were "well spoken of and filled with the Holy Spirit and wisdom" (vs.3). In addition, Stephen was a man full of faith and the Holy Spirit (vs. 5). Those qualities sound more spiritual than practical. Why are those qualities needed in ministering to people of the backgrounds where there's tension and jealousy?

Did the problem of Acts 6:1-6 stop the growth of the church? If the problem had not been resolved, would it have stopped the growth of the church? Are there any lessons for today?
